The bags to be used are made of compound films from PE/PA. The ultimate strength and tightness for most kind of waste are guaranteed by the thickness of the film material (160µ), the composition of two different film materials (PE/PA) and a double sealing line.

small setup



Function mode: MARI(naut is an external vacuum device. Only the open side of the waste bag is going to be inserted into the compact vacuum chamber. Gaseous bag contents are sucked off by a high performance suction pump. On vessels, the device is installed by using a wall fixation kit. There is no requirement for type approval by a classification society (Ref. DNV GL).
